Grantee	Awarded Amount	Project Description
Creation Mill CIC	£38,000.00	To transform Creation Mill CIC's existing warehouse space to house a new textiles hub to include an accessible workshop and training space, kitchen, toilets, a bigger scrap store and two rentable units for small businesses, providing incubator space.
The Eskdale Foundation	£3,750.00	To contribute to the salary costs of a part-time development and administrative manager, providing administrative and project development support to the Eskdale Foundation for one year.
Langholm Christmas Lights	£9,900.00	To replace two Christmas lights which say "Merry Christmas from Langholm" for the north and south entrances to Langholm and which showcase the village and provide welcoming entrances to it during the festive season.
St. Mungo Bowling Club	£15,000.00	To contribute towards the cost of constructing and fitting out a new clubhouse facility for use by players, visitors and the wider community, which will allow year-round social events and help reduce loneliness in the more elderly community.
Langholm Girls Football Club	£14,025.00	To contribute to the running costs of this new youth football club providing health and wellbeing benefits to girls aged seven to fourteen years in Langholm.
The Buccleuch Centre	£4,000.00	Towards the purchase of new kitchen equipment to enable the Centre to continue to host entertainment, community events, a cafe facility and conferences etc. which benefit the local community and businesses.
The Langholm Initiative	£37,500.00	To contribute to the cost of extending the Tarras Nature Valley Reserve 'Engaging with Nature' project officer post for a further three years, to develop the project and provide educational, outreach and volunteering opportunities.
Eskdalemuir Expressive Arts	£8,356.00	To support the cost of upgrading and creating a permanent multipurpose visual art space within Eskdalemuir Community Hub.
Langholm Common Riding	£3,400.00	To contribute towards the cost of renewing equipment which will enable the successful delivery of the Langholm Common Riding traditional event, which aims to celebrate cultural heritage and instil civic pride.
