Grantee	Total Amount Awarded	Project Summary
Tundergarth Parish Hall	£2,963.00	Towards the costs of renovating a currently unused room in the hall to be used as a social space with facilities for pool, darts, computer games, families to enjoy, meetings, and co-working space.
Lockerbie Bowling Club	£10,000.00	To part fund the refurbishment of the clubhouse toilets in order to improve the standard of facilities offered to members and visitors.
Xcel Youth Trust	£18,847.00	Towards the costs of establishing a sensory room within the local youth centre to provide new play and learning opportunities for children with disabilities and additional support needs.
Eskdale Curling Club	£1,125.00	To subsidise ice fees to mitigate against rising playing costs for the club's members.
Muckle Toon Media Ltd	£78,000.00	To contribute to the cost of employing a General Manager over the next three years.
D&G HandyVan (SCIO)	£30,000.00	To contribute towards the purchase of a hybrid van to allow staff to travel to and carry out repairs and improvements in the houses of vulnerable residents.
Langholm Playcare Ltd	£17,738.00	To contribute towards staffing, IT and training costs to allow Langholm Playcare to ensure that all staff are trained in child care, active play & learning and child development to a high standard.
Annandale Community Transport Services	£30,000.00	Towards the running costs of the community transport service for three years.
The Langholm Alliance	£3,761.00	Towards public realm improvements in the area of Langholm known as Wattie's Arch, increasing its visual appeal for visitors and residents.
Upper Eskdale Development Group	£90,000.00	Towards the hub's core running costs for three years to sustain it as an important community resource during a period of rising costs.
The Buccleuch Centre	£3,154.00	Towards the cost of purchasing new equipment for the centre, that will improve the quality of service offered and the working environment for staff and volunteers.
Westerkirk Parish Library	£23,491.00	To support initiatives aimed at increasing visitor numbers to, and membership of, Westerkirk Parish Library over the next three years.
RH Youth Organisation	£15,000.00	To assist with the purchase of a portacabin and storage container to provide a base for RH Youth Organisation and for wider community use.
